Thank you for sending
the grant application form which I am
pleased to return on behalf of the St.
James' Church Parsonage Appeal.

Our application is for funding towards
improvements to the church heating system,
which would be of great and obvious
benefit to all users of the church
building and thus to the community
rather than just the congregation.

We have given the space heater a
substantial trial and, backed up by the
repairs to the existing system, it will
provide effective heating. I enclose a

quotation recently received from J. F. Orange
and Son Ltd. the fan heater itself
(a new one with guarantee) will cost
an additional £580 - I have had to
return that quotation to Broughtons, as
they had mistakenly referred to St. Giles'
Church in Mafflock. I have requested
a corrected quotation, but am now concerned
about the application deadline.

We believe that these improvements,
added to lighting improvements which we
have already made, will be of significant
benefit to the village as a whole and
hope that the Parish Council will consider
them favorably.
